The interaction of the rotations, the resulting form(ation)s, the fluctuation between solid and fluid will play a major role. The sculpture will be developed with 6 women. Floatings works with the apparent suspension of gravity by hanging two bodies on top of each other, one supporting the other. Like in a salt water tank, body parts float freely, appear detached from the respective body, become a new form.

Lucinda Childs, who became famous at the Festival d' Avignon in 1979 thanks to her collaboration with Bob Wilson, is an icon of post-modern dance. She bequeathed three solos to her niece Ruth, which were created in New York, where there was an artistic atmosphere of departure at the time. In *Pastime* (1963), the dancer "sitting on a bathtub" intensifies the surface and volume effects by playing with a cloth that envelops her. With *Carnation* (1964), she systematically deconstructs her appearance with the help of trivial objects. Museum Piece (1965) makes an imagination come true: The dancer enters the interior of a painting (Le Cirque by Seurat), then humorously describes it through her body. The pieces have not gathered a bit of dust!






